WHEREAS, the City of Saint Paul, Department of Planning and Economic Development (PED) will incur costs for city staff, Amy Spong, to attend the Annual National Alliance of Preservation Commissions (NAPC) Forum in downtown Norfolk, Virginia on July 18, 2012 through July 22, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Historical Society is willing to provide a scholarship to the City for the costs of attendance by city staff, anticipated not to exceed \$1,300.00; with the remainder to be provided through PED's FY2012 Administrative Fund 126 Budget.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City Council authorizes PED to apply for, accept and enter into a grant agreement with the Minnesota Historical Society; and be it
