Authorizing the Police Department to accept a grant in the amount of \$53,760 from the Intitial Teaching Alpabet Foundation for the after school Police Activities League (PAL) and to amend the 2012 police special funds budget.

WHEREAS, the City of Saint Paul, Police Department (SPPD) has been granted funds in the amount of \$53,760 from the Initial Teaching Alphabet Foundation (ITA) for use during the 2012-2013 school year, and

WHEREAS, these funds are to be used to provide intervention in reading and writing for thirty five (35) to forty five (45) elementary and middle school students at three after school Police Activities League ITA Literacy Clinics; and

WHEREAS, the 2012 financing and spending plan needs to be amended for these funds; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor pursuant to Section 10.07.1 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul, does certify that there are available for appropriation funds of \$30,000 in excess of those estimated in the 2012 budget; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor recommends that the following addition be made to the 2012 budget; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that council accepts this grant and authorizes the City of Saint Paul to enter into, and Chief Thomas Smith to implement the attached agreement with the ITA Foundation; and

THEREFORE BE TIT RESOLVED, that the Saint Paul City Council approves these changes to the 2012 budget.
