WHEREAS, the City further finds that the public purposes of economic and community development realized through publication of The Line will be enhanced and served by a city expenditure of \$6,000 from its Marketing Budget.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council accepts this generous donation and extends its gratitude to the Central Corridor Funders Collaborative.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Saint Paul hereby authorizes the payment of grant money received and \$6,000 from the City's marketing budget for publication of The Line.
