WHEREAS, the City of Saint Paul has received a grant of \$588,721.00 from the State of Minnesota for the 2012 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Grant to purchase CBRNE equipment, technological equipment, provide staffing for the Emergency Management department, and to purchase emergency operation center equipment, and

WHEREAS, the financing and spending plans have not been established for the grant received, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor pursuant to Section 10.07.1 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul, does certify that there are available for appropriation funds of \$588,721.00 in excess of those estimated in the 2013 budget, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor recommends the following addition be made to the 2013 budget:
