Final Order to approve construction of the improvement of Montreal Avenue from Saint Paul Avenue to Snelling Avenue. (File No. 19111, Asmt. No. 135204)

In the Matter of approving the construction of the improvement of Montreal Avenue from Saint Paul Avenue to Snelling Avenue, by constructing a new, thicker section of bituminous pavement, construct ADA compliant pedestrian ramps at the intersections, install new storm sewer catch basins, new concrete driveway aprons and outwalks. Lantern style lighting will be installed as part of this project. Share-the-Road bike lane striping/signing will be installed.

Under Preliminary Order RES 13-684, approved 5/15/2013

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Saint Paul has conducted a public hearing upon the above improvement, due notice thereof having been given as prescribed by the City Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Council has heard all persons, objections and recommendations pertaining to said proposed improvement and has fully considered the same; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Saint Paul does hereby order that the above-described improvement be made, and the proper City officers are hereby directed and authorized to proceed with the improvement; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon the completion of said improvement, the proper City officers shall calculate all expenses incurred therein and shall report the same to the City Council in accordance with Chapter 14 of the City Charter.
