Comments: Two summary abatement orders were issued - 1) remove growth around boulevard tree obstructing public sidewalk; 2) remove tree debris around south of garage.

History of Orders on Property: 6/6/13: SA issued for garbage/rubbish; done by Parks. 8/23/12: SA issued to cut tall grass/weeds; remove garbage/rubbish; remove rank plant growth obstructing public sidewalk; done by owner. On-going complaints about condition of tree(s) in backyard, front yard, and boulevard; overgrowth of shrubs, grass/weeds, etc.

WHEREAS, the Office of Financial Services Real Estate Section has attached to this Council File both a report of completion outlining the costs and fees associated with Property Clean Up services during June 28 to July 31, 2013. (File No. J1401A, Assessment No. 148500) and the assessment roll including all properties for which these assessments are proposed for Council ratification; and
