1. That the said report and the same is hereby approved with no alternatives, and that the estimated cost thereof is \$74,000.00, to be financed by Met Council's Central Corridor LRT Project Funds.
2. That a public hearing be had on said improvement on the 6th day of November, 2013, at 5:30 p.m., in the Council Chambers of the City Hall and Court House Building in the City of Saint Paul.
3. That notice of said public hearing be given to the persons and in the manner provided by the Charter, stating the time and place of hearing, the nature of the improvement and the total cost thereof as estimated.
