History of Orders on Property: This is a C of O property. An emergency SA was issued on May 30, 2013 for a tree that fell onto the roof and severed the power lines. A complaint of utilities shut off in June 2013 with people continuing to reside at the property; tenants likely removed condemnation placards. A boarding work order was issued by the St. Paul Police Department on July 11, 2013.

WHEREAS, the Office of Financial Services Real Estate Section has attached to this Council File both a report of completion outlining the costs and fees associated with Property Clean Up services during August 1 to August 29, 2013.
