History of Orders on Property:

06/29/2010: Opening category II vacant building per condemnation by Fire Inspector Martin. I gave owner Mr Belmonte 7 days to restore water and appeal condemnation but he did not comply. At time of inspection I found house to be vacant and secure, yard acceptable. Several exterior code violations: Chimney damage, peeling paint on trim, siding damage, soffit/eave/fascia damage and a boarded window. See photos for violations. ~MD
