Comments: Only one EC letter with invoice was sent to the PO due to a glitch in the Amanda system; therefore, DSI recommends reducing the assessment from a total of \$275 to a total of \$155.00 (delete the assessment for Inv#1119050 as it was never mailed to PO).

History of Orders on Property: Ongoing history of scraping and rubbish in yard - numberous vehicle abatement orders, summary abatement orders, and correction notices issued to this property owner; tenant behavior issues; file remains open.

WHEREAS, the Office of Financial Services Real Estate Section has attached to this Council File both a report of completion outlining the costs and fees associated with Excessive Use of Inspection services billed June 21

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to September 3, 2014. (File No. J1503E, Assessment No. 158302) and the assessment roll including all properties for which these assessments are proposed for Council ratification; and

WHEREAS, the City Council's Legislative Hearing Officer has reviewed an appeal of this assessment and developed a recommendation for the City Council with respect to this assessment; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing having been conducted for the above improvement, and said assessment having been further considered by the Council and having been considered financially satisfactory; Now, Therefore, Be It

RESOLVED, that pursuant to Chapter 14 of the Saint Paul City Charter, said assessment is hereby ratified and reduced from \$275 to \$155.
