- 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 90 dBA as measured inside the tent at the wall opposite of the sound source.
- 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment who shall provide continuous sound level monitoring at each sound mix during the hours of the variance.
- 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 10:30 p.m. on March 14, 2015 and no later than 10:00 p.m. on March 17, 2015, the event dates.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that any violations of the conditions set forth above on the March 14, 2015 and on March 17, 2015 dates may result in denial of future requests for the grant of a noise variance, in addition to any criminal citation which might issue.

Patrick McGovern's, represented by Pat and Dianne Boemer, have requested an exemption from the sound level limitations in Chapter 293.07 in order to present amplified music, with limitations, from 3:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. (Midnight) on March 14, 2015 and from 3:00 p.m. until 12:00 a.m.(Midnight) on March 17, 2015. Chapter 293.09 provides for the granting of variances from the sound level limitations contained in Chapter 293.07.
