Approving adverse action against the Massage Practitioner license application submitted by Christopher James Burgess for 762 Cleveland Avenue South.

WHEREAS, the Massage Practitioner license application submitted by Christopher James Burgess (License ID #20140002236) for the premises located at 762 Cleveland Avenue in Saint Paul, was the subject of a Notice of Intent to Deny License dated February 23, 2015, stating on February 13, 2015, the license applicant filed a Petition to Enter a Guilty Plea in Hennepin County and was convicted of Gross Misdemeanor Criminal Sexual Conduct - 5<sup>th</sup> Degree - Nonconsensual Sexual Contact in violation of Minn. Stat. § 609.3451.1; and

WHEREAS, per Saint Paul Legislative Code §310.06 (b) (6) (c), the licensing office recommended license denial; and

WHEREAS, the licensee did not respond to the Notice of Intent to Deny License to either request a public or administrative hearing or withdraw his license application; and

WHEREAS, the Notice of Intent to Deny License stated that if the licensee failed to request a public or administrative hearing or withdraw his license application by March 5, 2015, that the matter would be placed on the consent agenda to impose the recommended penalty; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, the Massage Practitioner license application submitted by Christopher James Burgess is hereby denied.
