WHEREAS, the Mayor pursuant to Section 10.07.1 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul, does certify that there are available for appropriation funds of \$10,000 in excess of those estimated in the 2015 budget, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor recommends the following additional changes to be made to the 2015 budget:
