Approving adverse action against the Massage Practitioner license application submitted by Sara A. Lundequam at 493 Selby Avenue.

WHEREAS, the Massage Practitioner license application submitted by Sara A. Lundequam (License ID# 20140002647) for the premises located at 493 Selby Avenue in Saint Paul was the subject of a Notice of Intent to Deny License dated January 26, 2016, stating her application was in "pending" status until she submitted the following information: 1) a current certificate of General and Professional Liability insurance showing minimum coverage of \$1,000,000 each with a 30-day notice of cancellation and naming the City of Saint Paul as additional insured and 2) proof of affiliation with a City of Saint Paul licensed massage center or state licensed health facility; and

WHEREAS, the licensing office then recommended denial of her Massage Practitioner license; and

WHEREAS, the applicant failed to respond to the Notice of Intent to Deny License to submit the required information in order to continue the application process; and

WHEREAS, the Notice of Intent to Deny License stated that if the applicant failed to submit the required information or request a public or administrative hearing by February 5, 2016, that the matter would be placed on the consent agenda to impose the recommended penalty; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, the Massage Practitioner license application submitted by Sara A. Lundequam is hereby denied.
