WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has opened bids for the Wheelock Parkway Reconstruction Project; and

WHEREAS, there needs to be \$747,920 of SPRWS funding added to the program for work completed for SPRWS under the project; and

WHEREAS, there needs to be \$113,960 assessment funding added to the program to correctly reflect assessment financing; and

WHEREAS, there needs to be \$221,619 of Sewers funding added to the program for work completed for Sewers under the project; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor pursuant to Section 10.07.1 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul, does certify that there are available additional funds available for appropriation of \$1,083,499 in the Capital Improvement Budgets; and

Now, therefore be it, **RESOLVED**, by the Council of the City of Saint Paul, upon recommendation of the Mayor and advice of the Long Range Capital Improvement Budget Committee, that \$1,083,499 is available for appropriation in the Capital Improvements Budgets, as heretofore adopted and amended by this Council, be hereby further amended in the Improvement Budgets in the following particulars:
