WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has opened bids for the Jackson Street Reconstruction Project; and

WHEREAS, there needs to be \$1,635,648 of SPRWS funding added to the program for work completed for SPRWS under the project; and

WHEREAS, there needs to be \$193,617 Assessment funding added to the program to correctly reflect assessment financing; and

WHEREAS, there needs to be \$130,928 of Sewers funding added to the program for work completed for Sewers under the project: and

WHEREAS, the Mayor pursuant to Section 10.07.1 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul, does certify that there are available additional funds available for appropriation of \$1,960,193 in the Capital Improvement Budgets; and

Now, therefore be it, RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Saint Paul, upon recommendation of the Mayor and advice of the Long Range Capital Improvement Budget Committee, that \$1,960,193 is available for appropriation in the Capital Improvements Budgets, as heretofore adopted and amended by this Council, be hereby further amended in the Improvement Budgets in the following particulars:
