WHEREAS, the Mayor pursuant to Section 10.07.1 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul, does certify that there are available for appropriation funds of \$4,000 in excess of those estimated in the 2016 budget, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor recommends the additions as specified in the Attachment "MDH Financial Analysis \$4,000" be made to the 2016 budget;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Saint Paul City Council, on behalf of the residents of Saint Paul, accept this contribution of \$4,000 from the Minnesota Department of Human Services, extend their sincere appreciation to this organization, and approve the changes to the 2016 budget.
