Approving adverse action against the Sidewalk Contractor license held by Cornerstone Concrete LLC.

WHEREAS, the Sidewalk Contractor license held by Cornerstone Concrete LLC d/b/a Cornerstone Concrete LLC (License ID #20130002096) for the City of Saint Paul was the subject of a Notice of Intent to Suspend License dated July 8, 2016, stating the licensee failed to pay license late fee and submit a \$5,000 Sidewalk Bond; and

WHEREAS, per Saint Paul Legislative Code §310.05 (m) (2), the licensing office also recommended a \$500.00 matrix penalty for failure to submit required information to maintain the license; and

WHEREAS, the licensee did not respond to the Notice of Intent to Suspend License to pay the license late fee and submit required information or request a hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Notice of Intent to Suspend License stated that if the licensee failed to pay the license late fee and submit the required information or request a hearing by July 18, 2016, that the matter would be placed on the consent agenda to impose the recommended penalty; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, the Sidewalk Contractor license held by Cornerstone Concrete LLC d/b/a Cornerstone Concrete LLC is hereby suspended for failure to pay license late fees.

FURTHER RESOLVED, the licensee is ordered to pay a matrix penalty of \$500.00 for failure to submit required information in order to maintain the license.

FINALLY RESOLVED, the license will remain suspended license late fee is paid in full and all required information is submitted to the Department of Safety and Inspections.
