WHEREAS, this grant includes and in-kind match of \$5,000, and

WHEREAS, the financing and spending plans have not been established for the grant received, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor pursuant to Section 10.07.1 of the Charter of City of Saint Paul, does certify that there are available for appropriation funds of \$60,750 in excess of those estimated in the 2016 budget, and
