Approving adverse action against the Rental of Hospital Equipment license held by Jackson Medical Equipment, Inc., d/b/a Jackson Medical Equipment at 982 Thomas Avenue.

WHEREAS, the Rental of Hospital Equipment license held by Jackson Medical Equipment, Inc. d/b/a Jackson Medical Equipment (License ID #0024150) for the premises located at 982 Thomas Avenue in Saint Paul was the subject of a Notice of Intent to Suspend License dated February 28, 2017, stating the licensee failed to pay delinquent license and late fees; and

WHEREAS, per Saint Paul Legislative Code §310.05 (m) (2), the licensing office also recommended a \$500.00 matrix penalty for failure to submit required information to maintain the license; and

WHEREAS, the licensee did not respond to the Notice of Intent to Suspend License to pay the delinquent license and late fees and submit required information or request a hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Notice of Intent to Suspend License stated that if the licensee failed to pay the delinquent license and late fees and submit the required information or request a hearing by March 10, 2017, that the matter would be placed on the consent agenda to impose the recommended penalty; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, the Rental of Hospital Equipment license held by Jackson Medical Equipment, Inc. d/b/a Jackson Medical Equipment is hereby suspended for failure to pay delinquent license and late fees.

and be it,

FURTHER RESOLVED, the licensee is ordered to pay a matrix penalty of \$500.00 for failure to submit required information in order to maintain the license.

and be it,

FINALLY RESOLVED, the license will remain suspended until all delinquent license fees and penalties are paid in full and all required information is submitted to the Department of Safety and Inspections.
