Amending the financing and spending plans in the Fire Department in the amount of \$10,118.00 for the 2016 Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness Grant.

WHEREAS, the Fire Department applied for and received a grant of \$10,118 from the State of Minnesota for the 2016 Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness Grant to provide training for firefighters; and

WHEREAS, the grant includes an in-kind match of \$2,529.50; and

WHEREAS, the financing and spending plans have not been established for the grant received; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor pursuant to 10.07.1 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul, does certify that there are available for appropriation funds of \$10,118 in excess of those estimated in the 2017 budget; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor recommends the following additional changes to be made to the 2017 budget:
