City of Saint Paul and SPPR. The mission of The GRP Conservancy is to work with partners to further connect the Saint Paul community and region to its valued civic amenity, the Mississippi River; and

WHEREAS, the primary role of the GRP Conservancy will be to raise private funds to support GRP Initiative capital projects, operations and maintenance, and engagement programs. The Conservancy will also coordinate communications and marketing to generate increased awareness of the initiative and provide support to SPPR in public sector fundraising; and

WHEREAS, the concept of a GRP Conservancy has been vetted with City, and County political and staff leadership, civic and philanthropic leadership, and Saint Paul mayoral candidates, all to great support. Leadership recognized that the long -term success of the GRP Initiative hinges on private support which would be accessed by the Conservancy; and

WHEREAS, SPPR already has a previously established public/private partnership conservancy model in place with the nationally recognized Como Regional Park and Como Friends. The GRP Conservancy will be modeled on the Como Friends structure; and

WHER	EAS, if awarded the grant funds will be used to:
	create the founding board,
	apply for 501c3 status for the GRP Conservancy
	hire an Executive Director and supporting functional consultants,
	launch fundraising including cultivating individuals, foundations and corporations, communications
	and marketing; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the City of Saint Paul Department of Parks and Recreation Great River Passage Initiative is hereby authorized to apply for a F.R. Bigelow Foundation Grant, and if approved, accept the grant, and enter into agreements with the F.R. Bigelow Foundation as are necessary to accept the funding.
