Requesting that the City levy property taxes for the library agency.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Saint Paul Administrative Code §14.05, Mayor Coleman presented to the Library Board on August 16, 2017, the Library Agency's 2018 proposed budget, with said recommended budget totaling \$19,368,410; and

WHEREAS, the budget requested by the Library Agency and proposed by the Mayor includes, as part of the comprehensive 2018 financing plan for the Saint Paul Public Library Agency, that the net property tax levy payable in 2018 be \$17,985,237 as detailed below:
