WHEREAS, the Saint Paul City Council in Council File RES 17-1545 accepted the Report of Completion for Emergency Boarding and/or Securing of a Structure on Private Properties during the month of August 2017; and

WHEREAS, the City Council's Legislative Hearing Officer has reviewed the assessment roll, considered appeals of affected property owners and developed recommendations for City Council with respect to those assessments; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on January 17, 2018 to consider ratification of the assessment roll; and
