



2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 90 dBA as measured at 50 feet on Friday, March 16, 2018 from 1:00 p.m. until 6:30 p.m. and shall not exceed 95 dBA as measured at 50 feet from all sound sources on Saturday, March 17, 2018 from 2:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.

3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment who shall provide continuous sound level monitoring at each sound mix during the hours of the variance.

4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 6:30 p.m. on Friday, March 16 and 7:30 p.m. on Saturday, March 17, 2018.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that any violations of the conditions set forth above on any of the dates may result in revocation of the grant of a noise variance for the subsequent date(s), in addition to any criminal citation which might issue.

Visit Saint Paul, represented by Adam Johnson, Vice President of Marketing, has requested an exemption from the sound level limitations in Chapter 293.07 in order to provide DJ music in the parking lot of Cleveland Circle for the NCHC Fan Fest from 1:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. on Friday, March 16 and from 2:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Saturday, March 17, 2018. Chapter 293.09 provides for the granting of variances from the sound level limitations contained in Chapter 293.07.
