WHEREAS, the Police Department has space to store the trailer at the department's Citywide Services location located at 1820 Edgcumbe Road at no cost to the organization; and

WHEREAS, the public purpose is that the trailer can be quickly accessed and the Team Rubicon group can respond and be available to the Saint Paul community at any time of need; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that council authorizes the City of Saint Paul to enter into and Assistant Chief Kathleen Wuorinen to implement the Facilities Use Agreement with Team Rubicon.
