2. The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the variance conditions.
3. All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices will be turned off by 2:00 p.m. May 29 through June 1, for school sessions; 9:00 p.m. on June 1, and 8:30 p.m. on June 2, 2018.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that any violations of the conditions set forth above on any of the dates may result in revocation of the grant of a variance for the subsequent date(s), in addition to any criminal citation which might issue.

The Ordway, represented by Julia Erickson, Associate Production Manager, has requested an exemption from the sound level limitations in Chapter 293.07 in order to present live bands for the Flint Hills Family Festival, from May 29 through June 1 from 9:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. for children sessions; June 1 from 4:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. and June 2, 2018, from 10:00 a.m. to 8:30 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 9:00 a.m.. Chapter 293.09 provides for the granting of variances from the sound level limitations contained in Chapter 293.07.
