WHEREAS, the Minnesota Board of Firefighter Training and Education (MBFTE) has awarded a contribution of \$250,000 for the Fire Department to pay for training and equipment for the Minnesota Aviation Rescue Team (MART) and helicopter training with the Minnesota State Patrol; and

WHEREAS, the contribution will be used to pay for training and equipment for the MART team; and

WHEREAS, the City Council accepts this contribution from the MBFTE and thanks them for the generous gift; and

WHEREAS, the financing and spending plans have not been established for the contribution received; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor pursuant to Section 10.07.1 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul, does certify that there are available for appropriation funds of \$250,000 in excess of those estimated in the 2018 budget; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Saint Paul, that \$250,000 is available for appropriation in the 2018 budget, and said budget, as heretofore adopted by Council , is hereby amended as outlined in the attached financial analysis,
