



2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 95 dBA as measured at 50 feet from all sound sources outside of the fully enclosed tent from 12:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check from noon to 2:00 p.m.

3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment who shall provide continuous sound level monitoring at each sound mix during the hours of the variance.

4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 11:00 p.m. on March 16, 2019, on the event date.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that any violations of the conditions set forth above may result in denial of future requests for the grant of a noise variance, in addition to any criminal citation which might issue.

Burger Moe's, represented by Moe Sharif, has requested an exemption from the sound level limitations in Chapter 293.07 in order to present amplified music, with limitations, from 12:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. on March 16, 2019, with a pre-event sound check from noon to 2:00 p.m. Chapter 293.09 provides for the granting of variances from the sound level limitations contained in Chapter 293.07.
