Ratifying the assessments for Graffiti Removal services during October 24 to November 20, 2018. (File No. J1905P, Assessment No. 198404)

WHEREAS, the Saint Paul City Council in Council File RES 18-2115 accepted the Report of Completion for Graffiti Removal on Private Properties during the time period of October 24 to November 20, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City Council's Legislative Hearing Officer has reviewed the assessment roll, considered appeals of affected property owners and developed recommendations for City Council with respect to those assessments; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on March 20, 2019 to consider ratification of the assessment roll; and

WHEREAS, the City Council considered and found satisfactory the assessment of benefits, costs and expenses for the services provided; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that, pursuant to Chapter 14 of the City Charter and Chapter 60 of the Administrative Code, the assessments are hereby in all respects ratified with the exception of the following amendments which will be considered separately:

RLH TA 19-58: 735 Bellows Street; RLH TA 19-54: 500 Jackson Street; RLH TA 19-78: 1033 Seventh Street West; RLH TA 19-76: 1825-1827 University Avenue West; and be it further
