WHEREAS, there is a need to add \$204,000 MnDOT financing to the project budget; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor, pursuant to Section 10.07.1 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul, does certify that there is available for appropriation funds of \$204,000.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Saint Paul accepts the Safe Routes to School grant from MnDOT in the amount of \$204,000; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Saint Paul, upon recommendation of the Mayor and advice of the Capital Improvement Budget Committee, that \$204,000 is available for appropriation in the Capital Improvement Budgets, as heretofore adopted and amended by this Council, be hereby further amended in the Improvements Budgets in the following particulars:
