Stated Reason for Appeal (if given): I am living by myself in a side-by-side duplex where half of the house has been "unoccupied" for over three years and will remain unoccupied for at least another year, maybe longer. The "garbage cart size" card I returned to the City of Saint Paul before June 1st, 2018 was ignored. On it I had selected "one" small cart for my property. The "Unoccupied Dwelling Registration Form" I completed in November of 2018 has also been ignored. After two medium dumpsters were placed on my property I promptly contacted Ramsey County to inform them of the mistake and asked them to downsize my property to the "one cart" I selected. This request was answered only with me being told there was nothing that could be done. I was sent on a runaround lasting several months, and while late charges were being added to my bill, the haulers on my street weren't even picking up my garbage on a regular basis. "Advanced Disposal" was not prepared for the new business and changes to their routes...
