Amending Council File RLH AR 17-91 to delete the assessment for Collection of Vacant Building Registration Fees billed during March 27 to June 21, 2017 at 292 BURGESS STREET. (File No. VB1802, Assessment No. 188801)

WHEREAS on January 17, 2018, the City Council of the City of Saint Paul adopted Council File No. RLH AR 17-91, said Resolution being the Ratification of Assessment for Collection of Vacant Building Registration Fees billed during March 27 to June 21, 2017. (File No. VB1802, Assessment No. 188801); and

WHEREAS, the property at 292 Burgess Street, being described as: Atwater Street Addition to the City of St. Paul Ramsey County, Minn. Lot 2 Blk 1, with the property identification number 25-29-23-42-0127 was assessed an amount of \$2,284; and

WHEREAS, the property owner contacted City Council Office and indicated he has been living there since 2009 but it got referred to Fire inspections; and

WHEREAS, Department of Safety and Inspections staff recommends deleting the assessment because the property was only in the vacant building program for a few months as a Category 1;

WHEREAS, the Legislative Hearing Officer concurs with the recommendation; Now, Therefore, Be It

RESOLVED, that the reduction of \$2,284, plus any accrued interests, is deleted and the Offices of Financial Services will abate this reduction from the 2019 Property Taxes Statement.
