



- 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 90 dBA as measured 50 feet from sound source.
- 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. The applicant may need to provide a barrier, to act as a sound absorber to contain excess sound from leaving the area.
- 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 2:00 p.m. on the date of the event.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that any violations of the conditions set forth above on the first date may result in revocation of the grant of a variance for the subsequent date, in addition to any criminal citation which might issue.

American Foundation for Suicide Prevention has requested an exemption from the sound level limitations in Chapter 293.07 in order to present announcements and amplified music, with limitations, from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., on Sunday, September 15, 2019, for the Out of the Darkness Walk at the Como Park Pavilion, 1199 Midway Parkway. Chapter 293.09 provides for the granting of variances from the sound level limitations contained in Chapter 293.07.
