WHEREAS, the Saint Paul City Council in Council File RES 19-1031 accepted the Report of Completion for Collection of Delinquent Garbage Bills for services during January to March 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on September 11, 2019 to consider ratification of the assessment roll; and
