Authorizing the City of Saint Paul to enter into an agreement with the Minnesota Department of Revenue for the collection of Local Sales, Use Tax, and a Lodging Tax.

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Department of Revenue is authorized to administer, collect, and enforce Saint Paul local Sales, Use, and Lodging Taxes; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to effectively and efficiently collaborate to collect all authorized local taxes according to Laws of Minnesota 1993, Chapter 375, Article 9, Section 46; Laws of Minnesota 1982, Chapter 523, Article XXV Sections 1-3; amended Laws of Minnesota 1986 Chapter 462, Sections 28 and 31; amended Laws of Minnesota 1991, Chapter 291, Article 8, Section 31; amended Laws of Minnesota 2011, Chapter 112, Article 4, Section 6; amended Laws of Minnesota 2019, 1st Special Session, Chapter 6, Article 6, Section 6; Saint Paul Resolutions CF 93-783 and RES 19-1263; Saint Paul Ordinance numbers 17737, 17367, 17850, and 19-53; Minnesota Statutes Chapters 297A, 289A, and 270C; and Minnesota Rules 8130; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by the Saint Paul City Council, that:

- 1. The City of Saint Paul is authorized to enter into agreement with the Minnesota Department of Revenue for the Collection of Local Sales Tax, Use Tax, and a Lodging Tax; and
- 2. The proper City officials are authorized and directed to execute said agreement, and any other agreements or amendments, that are necessary to carry out this resolution.
