Stated Reason for Appeal (if given): I have not used my garbage services due to fire at my place. I am set up for garbage pick up every other week. I am happy to pay that amount.

Staff Comments: Property owner started occupying the property on 5/1/19 using a 35-gallon Every Other Week cart. Staff recommends reducing assessment to \$40.55 (removing the cost of 1 month of service - \$20.28). Staff has communicated this to property owner and he has made a payment of \$40.55 to Assessments dept on 10/2/19.

WHEREAS, the Office of Financial Services Real Estate Section has attached to this Council File both a report of completion outlining the costs and fees associated with Collection of Delinquent Garbage Bills for services during April to June 2019.
