Stated Reason for Appeal (if given): Amount for "additional bags" is unreasonable and arbitrarily set by hauler.

Staff Comments: According to information provided by Waste Management, the cart was open greater than 6" on 1/25/19. In the photo provided, however, staff does not see 4 extra bags. There is only 1 extra bag causing the cart to be propped open. Staff recommends reducing the assessment from \$12.00 to \$3.00 (the cost of one extra bag).
