Ratifying the assessments for Graffiti Removal services during January 21 to July 24, 2019. (File No. J2002P, Assessment No. 208401)

WHEREAS, the Saint Paul City Council in Council File RES 19-1428 accepted the Report of Completion for Graffiti Removal on Private Properties during the time period of January 21 to July 24, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City Council's Legislative Hearing Officer has considered objections of affected property owners and developed recommendations for the City Council with respect to their assessments; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on January 15, 2020 to consider ratification of the assessment roll; and

WHEREAS, the City Council considered and found satisfactory the assessment of benefits, costs and expenses for the services provided; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that, pursuant to the procedures set forth in Chapter 429 of Minnesota State Statutes and under the authority of Chapter 292 of the Legislative Code and Chapter 60 of the Saint Paul Administrative Code, the assessments are hereby in all respects ratified with the exception of the following amendments which will be considered separately:

RLH TA 19-727: 575-579 University Avenue West; RLH TA 19-770: 1058 University Avenue West;

RLH TA 19-726: 1622 White Bear Avenue North; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the assessments be payable in one (1) installment, unless specified by the Legislative Hearing Officer's recommended amendments.
