Staff Comments: Resident made out check #1313 for \$108.00 to Waste Management on 09/19/2019 to pay his Quarter 3 balance of \$127.50. Waste Management received check on 10/16/2019, after the delinquent Quarter 3 balance was submitted to the City of St. Paul. The amount was therefore credited to the account.
