



- 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 90 dBA as measured at 50 feet from all sound sources outside of the fully enclosed tents.
- 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment who shall provide continuous sound level monitoring at each sound mix during the hours of the variance.
- 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 10:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 14 and Sunday, March 15, 2020, the event dates.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that any violations of the conditions set forth above on the Saturday, March 14 and Sunday, March 15, 2020 dates may result in denial of future requests for the grant of a noise variance, in addition to any criminal citation which might issue.

Keg and Case Market, represented by Brock Parks, have requested an exemption from the sound level limitations in Chapter 293.07 in order to present live amplified music, with limitations, from 3:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m., Saturday, March 14 and Sunday, March 15, 2020. Chapter 293.09 provides for the granting of variances from the sound level limitations contained in Chapter 293.07.
