WHEREAS, the grant amount would be \$425,475, of which the federal government would provide \$382,927.50 to support this grant; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires a 10% match of \$42,547.50 which would be paid from the fire department's budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the City Council authorizes the Fire Department to apply for the 2019 Assistance to Firefighters Grant.
