Amending the previously ratified assessment to reduce the assessment for Collection of Vacant Building Registration Fees billed during August 14 to November 20, 2018 at 721 JACKSON STREET. (File No. VB1907, Assessment No. 198806)

WHEREAS on April 17, 2019, the City Council of the City of Saint Paul adopted Council File RLH AR 19-18, said Resolution being the Ratification of Assessment for Collection of Vacant Building Registration fees billed during August 14 to November 20, 2018. (File No. VB1907, Assessment No. 198806).

WHEREAS, the property at 721 Jackson Street, being described as: Lot 12 of Ashton and Sherburne's, Addition Ex Wly Part Measuring 100 Ft on NLY L and 104 Ft on Sly L Lot 12, the Ely 100 Ft of Lot 13 & Ely 85 Ft of Lot 14 Blk 13, with the property identification number 31-29-22-21-0093 was assessed an amount of \$2284.00; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Hearing Officer recommended reducing the assessment from \$2284 to \$1713 and the terms of the reduction were met by the property owner;

WHEREAS, on May 15, 2019, the Council of the City Saint Paul adopted Council File RLH TA 19-323 to reduce this amended assessment; however, it was missed by Office of Financial Services and the full amount plus interest was sent to owner's 2020 taxes; Now, Therefore Be It,

RESOLVED, that Council Files RLH AR 19-18 and TA 19-323 are hereby amended to reduce the difference from the 2020 Property Taxes.
