WHEREAS, the Saint Paul City Council in Council File RES 20-348 accepted the Report of Completion for Excessive Use of Inspection or Abatement Service for Property Code Violations billed during the time period of October 22 to November 21, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City Council's Legislative Hearing Officer has considered objections of affected property owners and developed recommendations for the City Council with respect to their assessments; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on May 20, 2020 to consider ratification of the assessment roll; and
