**Stated Reason for Appeal (if given):** The property has been "Registered Vacant" property with the city since 11/22/2019. Therefore they should not have to pay full Q4 2019 bill.

**Staff Comments:** Republic confirmed that the account has been closed since 11/22/2019. They stated that they will generate the credit for Q1 2020 and requested that we remove \$192.16 from the pending Q4 2019 assessment. Carts have been schedule to be removed on 03/02/2020. Staff recommends removal of the assessment.
