WHEREAS, the Saint Paul City Council in Council File RES 20-22 accepted the Report of Completion for Collection of Delinquent Garbage Bills for services during July to September 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City Council's Legislative Hearing Officer has considered objections of affected property owners and developed recommendations for the City Council with respect to their assessments; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on March 25, 2020 to consider ratification of the assessment roll; and
