Stated Reason for Appeal (if given): We have received a notice of assessment for a garbage bill -- \$3.36. This \$3.36 was paid with our garbage bill in April 2020.

Staff Comments: Hauler confirmed that a late fee of \$3.36 was incorrectly added to the Quarter 2 2020 invoice. They stated that they have credited the amount to the account. Therefore staff recommends approving the assessment.
