**Stated Reason for Appeal (if given):** This amount was paid directly to our garbage hauler on April 14, 2020 as included on an invoice from them. Your assessment is a double billing of this amount.

**Staff Comments:** Hauler confirmed that the late fee of \$4.97 from Quarter 1 2020 was incorrectly added to the Quarter 2 2020 invoice. Therefore staff recommends removing the assessment.
