Title: Authorizing an increase in the Parks and Recreation Grant Fund Budgets in the amount of \$1,420,000 to reflect various grant funding awarded in 2021 and establish the appropriate grant activity budgets. These grants include the following: State of MN DEED Right Track Grant (additional funding of \$700,000 for State Fiscal Year 2021), Right Track CDBG Grant (\$400,000 additional funding for 2021), EAB funding from MN DNR (additional grant funding of \$30,000 for SFY 2021), Twins Grant (\$100,000 additional funding for 2021) and non-grant 2021 project budgets for Environmental Services (\$100,000) and Arts and Gardening Services (\$90,000).

Amending the financing and spending plan in the Department of Parks and Recreation in the amount of \$175,440.65 to utilize Parkland Dedication funds for the Westgate Park creation project.

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Recreation is currently creating a new park named Westgate Park; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Department of Parks and Recreation to transfer Parkland Dedication funds of \$175,440.65 to the Westgate Park project for park improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Recreation wishes to amend the existing financing and spending budget for the project to reflect said funds; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor, pursuant to Section 10.07.1 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul, does certify that there are available for appropriation, funds of \$175,440.65 in excess of those estimated in the 2021 Capital Improvement Budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Saint Paul, upon recommendation of the Mayor and the advice of the Long Range Capital Improvement Budget Committee, that \$175,440.65 is available for appropriation in the 2021 Capital Improvement Budget, and said 2021 budget, as heretofore adopted by the Council, is hereby further amended.
