WHEREAS, the City of Saint Paul encourages the Governor and Legislature to view all legislative action through an equity lens and ensure that legislation proposed and passed avoids further marginalization and continuing disparities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Saint Paul is amending its 2021 Legislative Agenda to include and support various resiliency, transit, immigration, economic development, and racial justice proposals; now, therefore be it
